

HALLOWED BE YOUR NAME

‘Delight yourself in the Lord and he will give you the desires of your heart.’ (Psalm 37:4, ESV)

Our prayers are often a long list of things we want God to do for us. OUR desires... of OUR hearts. But the Lord’s Prayer starts with God. The first half of its petitions are for God. For His glory. His agenda. His ways.

Starting with God reorders the desires of our hearts. We realize what is most important. Nothing is better than for God to be hallowed, than for all of life to be under his rule, and all to happen according to his will. Just like heaven.

Starting with God aligns our desires with his. Not only that, it also helps us believe that he is willing, able and near to meet our desires.
